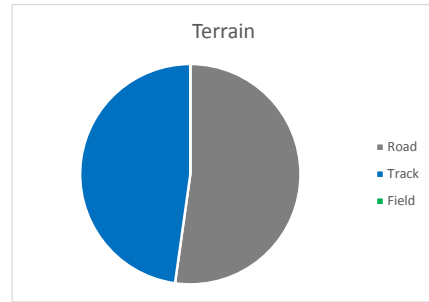


# Coxhoe Garmondsway Circular

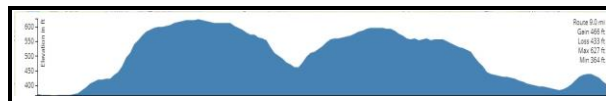

## Instructions

- 1 Exit the leisure centre through the corner path. On the main road cross over and take the road up to Coxhoe tip. At the end of the new housing, take the path left all the way up the hill to the top (through Crowtrees nature reserve).  
At the top of this path, don't come out onto the road but take the left path through the trees. This brings you out alongside the play park. Turn right, and then
- 2 at the crossroads in Quarrington Hill turn left at the Half Moon Pub. Follow this road past Cassop Primary School and then turn immediately right on the track into the plantation (pit heaps)  
Once in the pit heaps follow the path around left (not downhill yet) and keep the height. This section is the reverse of the Coxhoe Trail 10k. Take the right turn
- 3 at the edge of plantation, which starts to take you downhill. Follow this down for half a mile and through the trees take a right turn over the small concrete drainage bridge. Follow this contour and then take a left down and out of the plantation at the bench, out through the boulders at the bottom. This brings you onto the road at the very bottom of the hill near Kelloe.  
Turn left and follow the road up the steep hill. Ignore the first right turn (for Kelloe/Coxhoe) but take the second right (no sign) after it has levelled out. This
- 4 road climbs slowly for a mile and includes wind turbines on the left. After the bend, take the right turn, and quarter of a mile later take the right turn into the footpath. This is the familiar path at the top of the old railway line (on the Pie and Peas route).
- 5 Take this path (the old railway line) down to Garmondsway and then join the single track road to the A177 near Coxhoe, nearly 2 miles in total. Turn right on the A177 and then right again into Coxhoe. At Coxhoe traffic lights turn left and head back to the leisure centre.
